



BOWLING CONT: On the Varsity Girls side, honors were received by Kristen Young, who rolled the girls high game of 277 as well as 209 & 192 for a 678 series to finish in 2nd place and Ashley Yank, who scored 187, 182 & 225 for a 594 series to finish tied for 9th place on the All Tournament Team. In the Macomb County JV Championships, Matt Kudwa had scores of 235, 224 & 210 for a 669 series to earn a place on the All Tournament Team.



In the dual meet against Eisenhower last Thursday Senior Craig Pertler lowered his own team record in the 100 Fly from a 55.55 to a 54.27 and in doing so qualified for the State Meet with a time that is over a second faster than the time cut. Sophomore Ben Pitlock broke the school record in the 200 IM with a time of 2:05.77 that was previously held by Kevin Schnieders with a time of 2:06.22. The team won all three relays and 5 individual events to win the meet 107-73. Their record is now 2-0 in the MAC RED and 5-1 overall.

The team also finished in first place overall at the Romeo Relay Meet. We had 5 relays place first and in doing so set 3 meet records at the meet (listed below). They finished in the top 3 in 10 out of the 12 events.
